ROOT CANALS:

Root canal treatment is about 90% successful. They do occasionally fail. If you lose your tooth within 3 years due to failure of the root canal, we will refund half of the root canal fee, or apply it as a credit towards a replacement tooth.

COMPOSITE (tooth colored) FILLINGS:

If a composite restoration is the recommended treatment of choice, we will replace or repair it in the event of failure for a period of **3 years**. If the tooth breaks and requires a crown or onlay, we will credit the cost of the filling towards the crown or onlay.

DENTAL IMPLANTS:

If the implant fails to integrate we will replace, it up to 1 year.

PFM (porcalain-fused-to-metal) AND ALL METAL INLAYS, ONLAYS, CROWNS, AND BRIDGES are warrantied for 3 years.

ALL CERAMIC AND RESIN INLAYS AND ONLAYS, CROWNS AND BRIDGES

carry a **1 year** warranty. We will replace or repair them at no charge during this period if they break, are lost, or decay with normal use. (This does not include accidents that could also break normal healthy teeth or elenching and grinding habits).

THE ABOVE RESTORATIONS ARE NOT COVERED IF ROOT CANAL TREATMENT NEEDS TO BE DONE THRU IT AFTER PLACEMENT.

DENTURES AND PARTIAL DENTURES:

We will warranty dentures and partials for a period of **3 years** if a tooth chips, breaks, or a flange or frame breaks under normal use. This warranty does not cover accidents such as dropping your denture. Full upper and lower denture patients must be seen once every 18 months.

PATIENTS WITH SOME OF THEIR NATURAL TEETH MUST BE SEEN AT THE PRESCRIBED RECALL APPOINTMENT OR THIS WARRANTY IS NULL AND VOID (minimum every 6 months).

******IMPORTANT NOTE******

As you can see, we are confident of the durability of our treatment as prescribed for you. The primary key to your long term success is spending a few minutes a day on your home care: brushing, flossing, using fluoride, and using prescribed products. The second key to success is regular professional examinations, cleanings, X-rays, and fluoride treatments (2, 3, 4, & 6 month intervals, depending on your condition). Finally, the last key to your long term success is wearing a NIGHTGUARD, if it was recommended for you due to your clenching and grinding habits. This warranty does not cover accidents that cause damage to the teeth or dental prosthesis. FAILURE TO HAVE THESE REGULAR VISITS WITH OUR OFFICE AND NOT FOLLOWING THE RECOMMENDED TREATMENT AS MENTIONED ABOVE VOID ALL WARRANTIES. Help us help you maintain your teeth for a lifetime.

Is there a warranty on your dental services?

The long term success of the dental treatment we provide for you depends upon your continuing home care of your teeth and gums, regular professional exams, cleaning and fluoride treatments. The products recommended by us for you and the frequency of those regular visits depend on your individual condition. Those visits may be every 6, 4, 3, 2, or even 1 month apart, depending on your oral health. YOU MUST KEEP THE PRESCRIBED REGULAR RECALL APPOINTMENTS OR THESE WARRANTIES ARE NULL AND VOID (minimum every 6 months). With that in mind we offer the following limited dental warranties:

DENTAL SEALANTS:

Sealants are plastic coating placed on the chewing surfaces of the teeth to prevent decay in the pits and grooves of the teeth. These are the most common areas to get cavities. Floss and the use of fluoride will help prevent decay between the teeth. We will repair or replace sealants for a period of 3 years after placement at no cost. If decay is present on the chewing surface, the replacement filling will be done at no charge.

DENTAL AMALGAMS:

Although it is an option, our office does not use amalgam (silver fillings) as a standard of care. We offer Composite (tooth colored) fillings.
